The Dalia Festival is the biggest expression of Israeli folk dances in Argentina and it's a trademark in our community's calendar. This year we are sharing the joy of celebrating its 20th edition, and that's why we want to celebrate it big time.

We will be hosting two of the best known and most prestigious choreographers of the moment. From Israel, **Michael Barzelai**, and from Los Ángeles, **Sagi Azran**.
